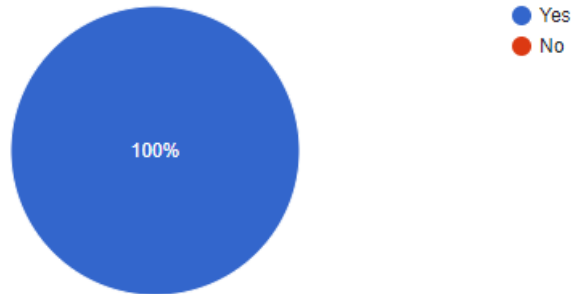


Summer School Feedback Analysis

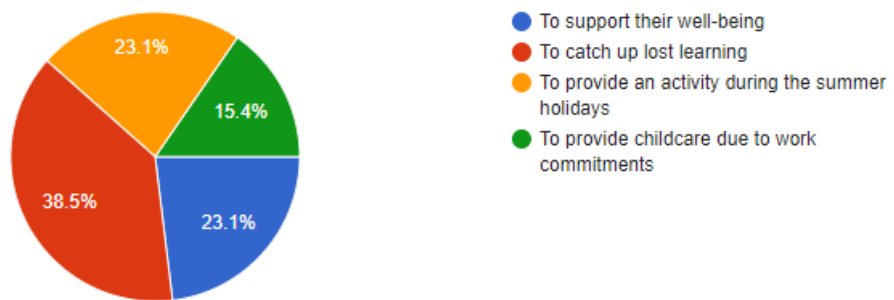
Did your child enjoy summer school?

13 responses



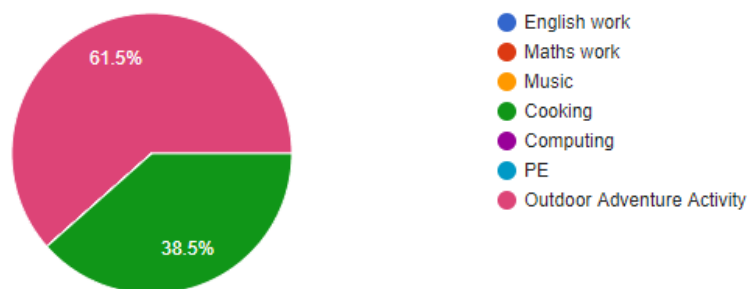
What was the main reason for sending your child to summer school?

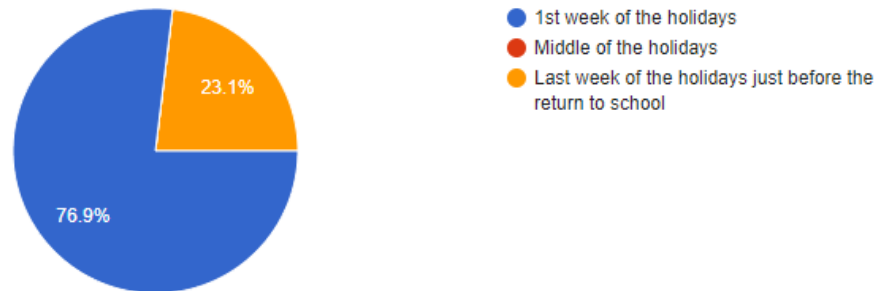
