



### **General Appearances:**

Pupils are expected to look smart and ready to learn.

Only one pair of stud earrings may be worn which must be removed for PE and games.

No other piercings are permitted.

Make up and nail varnish are not permitted.

Hair should be a natural colour, not be dyed, and in a smart style suitable for school (not with clipped patterns and no shorter than 6mm/a number 2)

Hair longer than the shoulders must be tied back for practical science, technology and PE with a black or brown hairband.

Parents are encouraged to check with school prior to making a purchase if they are in any doubt as to whether certain items are suitable for school.

If your child does not meet the required standards of appearance, parents/carers will be contacted to rectify the situation at the earliest opportunity.

### **Everyday Uniform:**

- \*Navy blue V neck jumper with school logo
  - *To mark 50 years of Horringer Court we will have a new logo on the school jumper. Both the new style and old style logos will be acceptable for school.*
- White shirt with collar
  - **Shirts** – we require all shirts to be tucked into skirts and trousers.
- \*School tie
- Black trousers, tailored shorts or black skirt
  - **Skirts** - **MUST** be knee length or longer,
  - **Trousers and/or Shorts** - should be tailored - not jeans, sports trousers, flared, skinnies or 'fashion' trousers.
- Standard black school shoes
  - **Shoes** - **MUST** be black sensible shoes which must not have sports logos.  
To comply with safety regulations for DT, Food Tech and Science shoes **MUST** be of a sturdy material,  
Boots, high heels, sandals, flip flops, plimsolls, canvas shoes are **NOT** permitted.
- Black socks or tights.
  - **Socks** - Must be plain black with no visible logos and ankle length or longer. Trainer socks are not permitted
- No jewellery, except for a watch and one plain stud in each ear.

**Equipment:** for all lessons we ask that the pupils all bring the following items;

- A pencil case containing a black pen, pencil, 30cm ruler, eraser and pencil sharpener.
  - Coloured pencils may also be useful as well as a calculator.(Casio 85GT-Plus recommended)
- A modestly sized bag is needed in which to carry school books and additional P.E. kit.
- We encourage all children to bring in their own water bottle with a sports top.
- Children should not bring valuable items into school.

- If you wish your child to bring their mobile phone to school then it is done at your own risk.
  - Mobile phones **MUST** be switched off at all times when on the school premises, as stated in the school rules. Mobile phones must not be used in school.
  - On trips and visits (including fixtures) they may only be switched on with the permission of the member of staff in charge.
  - Mobile phones cannot be used in school, phones **WILL** be confiscated and **ONLY** returned to a parent.
  - If a phone is used in school students can be internally or externally excluded as a consequence.
